

PROMOTION POLICY

Pre School to Class II

- Evaluation and assessment is a continuous process which is done on the basis of overall performance.
- The assessment is carried out in all domains of development. ie physical, social, language and creativity. The skills and competencies, verbal interactions as well as behaviour is assessed. Age appropriate activities and activity sheets are given regularly to check the child's performance.
- ❖ The assessment is done for three terms in an academic year. There is no formal examination.
- ❖ All the children are promoted to the next class(for classes PS and PP)
- No retention policy as per RTEA, 2009. Class to be repeated with the consent of the parents (Classes I and II).

Classes III to VIII

1. Attendance

- * 75% attendance is compulsory for promotion to the next higher class.
- ❖ 15% shortage in attendance can be condoned by the Principal on account of medical grounds (to be validated with medical certificate).
- ❖ Case of candidate with less that 60 % attendance will be put up for condonation to the Principal.

2. Assessment:

- ♦ However both terms will be treated separate without including portion of 1st term in the 2nd term for classes I to V.
- Question paper of the annual examination would be set out of the second term syllabus plus 10% of 1st term for class VI,20% of 1 term for class VII and 30% of 1st term for class VIII.
- ❖ Weightage of Cycle examination (20) which includes Pen and Paper test (10), Note book(05) and Subject Enrichment (05) along with the marks obtained in the Half Yearly (80) and annual examination(80) is projected term wise in the progress report.
- ❖ Grades on a three point grading scale is awarded term wise for co-scholastic areas (Work Education, Art Education, Health and Physical Education and Discipline)

3. Promotion Policy

No retention policy as per RTEA, 2009. Class to be repeated with the consent of the parents.

Class IX

1. Attendance

- ❖ 75% attendance is compulsory for promotion to the next higher class.
- ❖ 15% shortage in attendance can be condoned by the Principal on account of medical grounds (to be validated with medical certificate).
- ❖ Case of candidate with less than 60 % attendance will be put up for condonation to the Principal

3. Promotion Policy

- ❖ To be promoted to class X ,a student must secure 33% in each subject in annual exam and Internal marks taken together
- ❖ A student scoring less than 33% cumulative in 03 or more subjects will be detained in class IX
- ❖ A student scoring less than 33% marks in one or two subjects will be given compartment.
