Missed Test / Exams

- A) If a student has missed any tests/exams except on duty/competitions on behalf of school or due to genuine medical reasons, no average shall be given i.e., the student will be marked zero and there will be no retest.
- B) If a student has missed any of PT1/PTII/both due to duty on behalf of school or genuine medical reasons, retest shall be conducted only once in second term.
- C) If a student has missed the Mid Term Test due to duty on behalf of school or genuine medical reasons, retest shall be conducted.
