## Missed Test / Exams

A) If a student has missed any tests/exams except on duty/competitions approved by the school authorities or due to genuine medical reasons, no average shall be given i.e., the student will be marked zero and there will be no retest.
B) If a student has missed any of PT1/ PTII/ both due to duty on behalf of school or genuine medical reasons will be given proportionate marks.
C) If a student has missed the Mid Term Test due to duty on behalf of school or genuine medical reasons, retest shall be conducted.
D) If a student has missed the Annual Exam due to duty on behalf of school or genuine medical reasons, will be allowed to take exam in the subject(s) which he missed.

- Absentee students in any exam of main subjects will not be considered for merit positions under any category except those who participate in the Inter-School Competitions (Sports / Co Scholastic) duly approved by the Principal.
