## ASSESSMENT AND PROMOTION POLICY

Every student must have a minimum of $75 \%$ attendance, failing which he/she will not be allowed to sit in the final examination / will not be promoted to the next higher class.

Please discourage the student from missing an exam unless on grounds of extreme emergency like a contagious disease, a fracture etc.

## PROMOTION POLICY AND CUMULATIVE RESULT

1. In order to be declared as having passed the class IX examination, the student must have obtained 33 marks in the aggregate and $33 \%$ in each subject.
2. According to CBSE circular no. CBSE/AS (COORD)/IA/X/2020, dated 31.01.2020, In the scholastic area, a student needs to secure overall 33\% marks (both Pen Paper Test \& Internal Assessment taken together) (i.e $D$ Grade) to be able to pass that subject.
3. A student scoring less than $33 \%$ (i.e E grade) in more than 2 subjects will be detained. Retest is permitted in a maximum of 2 subjects only.
4. The retest(Compartment Examination) will be conducted on the same pattern of annual examination i.e. three hours duration and 80 marks.

## Missed Test / Exams

A) If a student has missed any tests/exams except on duty/competitions approved by the school authorities or due to genuine medical reasons, no average shall be given i.e., the student will be marked zero and there will be no retest.
B) If a student has missed any of PT1/ PTII/ both due to duty on behalf of school or genuine medical reasons will be given proportionate marks.
C) If a student has missed the Mid Term Test due to duty on behalf of school or genuine medical reasons, retest shall be conducted.
D) If a student has missed the Annual Exam due to duty on behalf of school or genuine medical reasons, will be allowed to take exam in the subject(s) which he missed along with the students taking the re-examination.
E) Use of unfair means

Strict Disciplinary action will be taken against the students using unfair means. Their answer scripts will be canceled and no extra time will be given. Only a new answer script will be assessed. Repeated unfair means will invite major penalization.

## Assessment of Co-scholastic Areas:

Assessment of co-scholastic areas will be done as per CBSE guidelines.
