Steps to Download and Access the CBSE Reading App:

- 1. Go to your device's App Store or Play Store.
- 2. Search for "CBSE Reading App by Freedom" in the search bar.
- 3. Install the app on your device.
- 4. Once the installation is complete, open the app.
- 5. Click on the 'Get Started' button to create your account or log in if you already have one.
