Missed Test / Exams

- If a student has missed any tests/exams except on duty/competitions on behalf of school or due to genuine medical reasons, no average shall be given i.e., the student will be marked zero and there will be no retest.
- If a student has missed any of PT1/PT2 due to duty on behalf of school or genuine medical reasons , then the one for which the child has appeared will be counted for the assessment and proportionate marks will be allotted for the other.
- If a student has missed both PT1 and PT2 due to duty on behalf of school or genuine medical reasons , then retest will be conducted in once in second term.
- If a student has missed the Half Yearly Exam due to duty on behalf of school or genuine medical reasons , retest shall be conducted .
- In any other specific case, the decision will rest with the school examination committee.

Note

- For the academic year 2024-25 , full attendance award will be given for the students securing 100% attendance from 01 April 2024 to 31 March 2025
- Absentee students in any Exam of Main subjects will not be considered for merit positions under any category except participation in the Inter-School Competition (Sports / Co Scholastic) on behalf of school.
- Merit positions will be decided on the basis of total of the aggregate of annual result of main subjects (out of 100) and points scored in Bal Sabha activities
